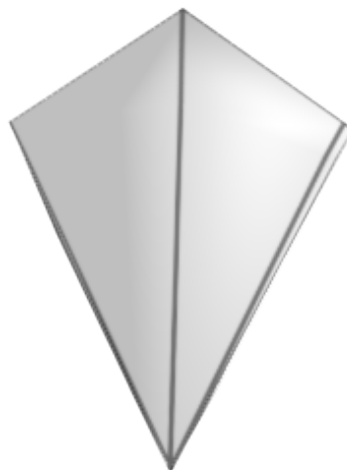

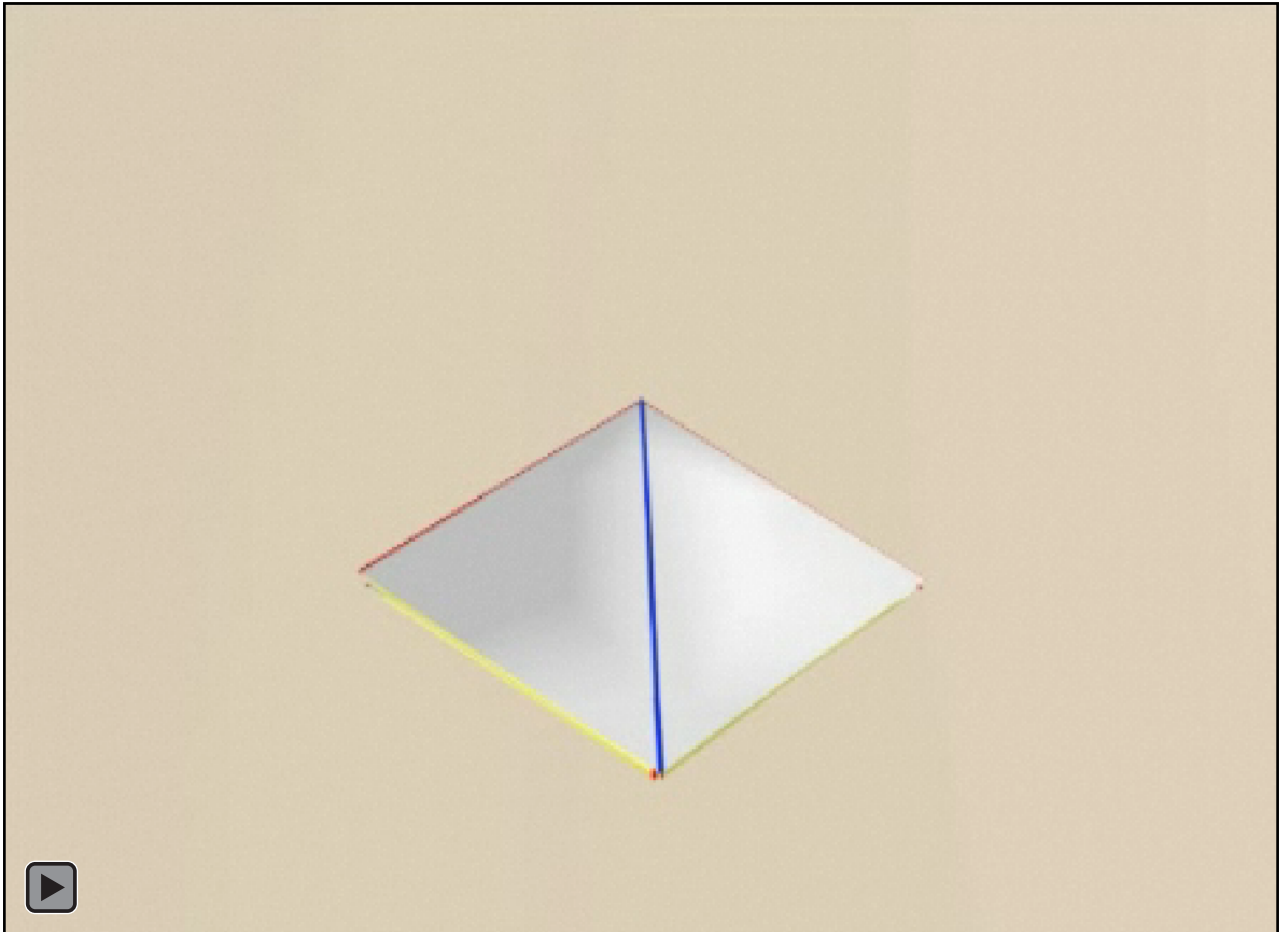

Klick and watch the whole folding animation of the BIRD:



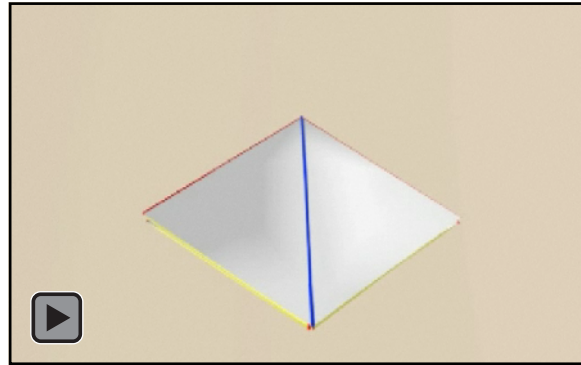
The bird is one of many basic figures and quite easy to fold. There are some figures which are based on the bird like the crane or the swan for example. The basic form of the bird is the *preliminary base*. You are just two foldings away from the bird folding.

Don't forget to retighten every fold with your fingernail!

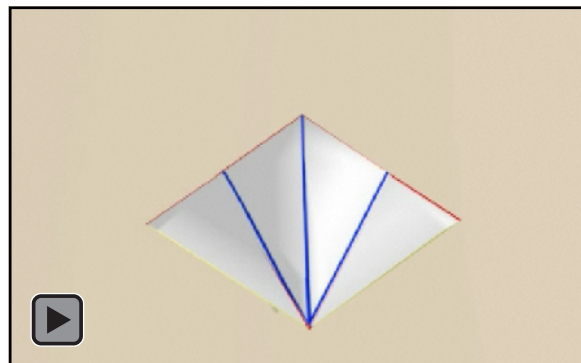
Step #1:

Fold the raw edges of the top layer in so that they lie exactly along the center folding and open the foldings afterwards.

Open the top layer and fold the left and the right side in. Bring the top flap down again.

**Step #2:**

After you have turned the paper around redo step one.



That's your folded bird.

Step #3:

Fold the upper and lower edges down (or do a horizontally or vertically mountain fold) and hold the paper in the air.

After you hold both outermost edges of the folding between your thumbs and forefingers push both edges together. The paper should interfold itself automatically.

Now turn the front edge to the left and the edge at the back to the right.

That's the preliminary base.
